- 1. Applicants in the above matter were previously employed by the respondent, who transports waste products to and between various land-fill sites within the Ekurhuleni district.
- 2. Ms Mdluli submitted that those employees engaged in the transportation of such waste products, using heavy duty trucks for that purpose, falls within the scope of the National Bargaining Council for Road Freight and Logistics Industry. Those employees, however, not engaged in the transportation, per se, and who are employed at the various land-fill sites, do not fall within the scope of the said Bargaining Council.
- 3. Ms Mdluli confirmed that those employees engaged in the transportation of such waste product have been registered with the Bargaining Council, which was confirmed by the representatives of the said Bargaining Council.
- 4. Miya Mdluli Investment CC won a successful tender to dispose of waste products at various land-fill sites within Ekurhuleni. The general workers (40 are employed) are employed to ensure that the various sites are well maintained and meet the Council's health and hygienic requirements. These employees are not engaged in the transportation of any material or goods and these employees are merely engaged in the cleaning operations, as described.
- 5. The Bargaining Council representative referred to the Demarcation Award between the same Bargaining Council and Compass Waste Services (Pty) Limited (KNDB 7196-11), wherein, at paragraph C under the heading, DETERMINATION, the following is recorded "Insofar as the company and some of its employees are engaged or employed in waste treatment, they are not engaged or employed in the Road Freight Sector, and the Collective Agreements are not binding on them."
- 6. The Bargaining Council, submitted that inasmuch as those general workers engaged in maintaining the land-fills, are concerned, they are not engaged nor employed in the Road Freight Sector, and those employees are not required to register within the National Bargaining Council for Road Freight and Logistics Industry.
- 7. Inasmuch as the drivers and those engaged in the Road Freight Industry are concerned, I am satisfied that those employees have been duly registered with the Bargaining Council, and no Order nor Award will be required in respect of those employees.

8. Those employees who are not engaged in the road freight industry, per se, and who are employed as "general workers" are not required to be registered with the Bargaining Council.
