NBCRFLI WELCOMES NEW TRADE UNION PARTY TO COUNCIL

The Parties to the National Bargaining Council for the Road Freight and Logistics Industry (NBCRFLI) have approved the admission of TIRISANO Transport and Services Workers Union (TASWU) as a provisional party to the Council, effective 18 August 2023.

This comes after the union's application for admission as a Trade Union party to Council received the green light at the Council's Annual General Meeting (AGM) held on 31 July 2023 after the union met the admission threshold.

The Council's constitution was amended and certified by the Registrar of Labour Relations on 18 August 2023 in accordance section 57(2) of the Labour Relations Act (LRA) to include TIRISANO Transport and Services Workers union as a new trade union party to the Council.

"We welcome TASWU and trust that the union will add value to the Industry and contribute to the promotion of orderly collective bargaining," said the NBCRFLI National Secretary, Musa Ndlovu.

TIRISANO Transport and Services Workers union joins other trade unions who are party to the Council, namely: South African Transport and Allied Workers' Union (SATAWU) and Motor Transport Workers' Union of South Africa (MTWU) and employer associations: Road Freight Association (RFA), National Employers'

Association of South Africa (NEASA) and Consolidated Employers Organisation (CEO).
