NBCRFLI to open branch office in Clanwilliam

The National Bargaining Council for the Road Freight and Logistics Industry (NBCRFLI) will open a new branch office in Clanwilliam, in the Western Cape, on 1 June 2011. Driven by the need of road freight and logistics industry employers and employees for speedy access to Council offices, the new office will specifically service the N7 route. This route will be regarded as all surrounding areas, from Mooreesburg into the Northern Cape until the furthest points of Pofadder and Alexander Bay.

"The opening of the Clanwilliam branch office is an important step in increasing our national footprint to 18 offices countrywide," says Joe Letswalo, CEO of the NBCRFLI. "We believe that the new office will increase accessibility of services to industry members, in particular, 59 employers and 593 employees based in that area. The organisation that is today known as the National Bargaining Council for the Road Freight and Logistics Industry (NBCRFLI) has been in existence since 1946

The Council is a service-centred organisation whose mandate is to facilitate, mediate and set minimum standards and conditions of employment between industry employers and employees within the road freight and logistics industry. The ultimate focus of Council is on upgrading the quality of service delivered to its stakeholders. The establishment of the Clanwilliam branch office is a leap towards fulfilling that goal.
