DEADLINE FOR THE LEAVE PAY FUND APPLICATIONS-TEMPORARY RELIEF MEASURES FOR INDUSTRY EMPLOYERS AND EMPLOYEES AMIDST COVID-19

- 1. After the declaration of the 21 days (27 March-16 April) national lockdown by the President, the NBCRFLI proactively resolved to put in place various temporary relief measures to mitigate the negative impact of the national lockdown regulations and COVID-19. One of these temporary relief measures was the industry applying for 21 days leave pay contributions from the Leave Pay Fund.
- 2. The NBCRFLI wishes to advise the industry that, the deadline for the Leave Pay Fund applications for the 21 days national lockdown period is **Friday**, **24 April 2020 at 16H00.** Applications will no longer be accepted after this deadline.
- 3. All employers who have applied for this Leave Pay Fund including the Leave Advancement are urged to submit their Unemployment Insurance Fund (UIF) Temporary Employer/Employee Relief Scheme (TERS) applications directly to the NBCRFLI for submission to UIF as well as reconciliation purposes.
